When Newport Beach-based designer Laura Brophy (brophyinteriors.com) remodels a home, bathrooms are the spaces that often "require the most love," she says. But doing one right—like this elegant Huntington Beach haven, one key savor of a recent whole-home renovation—is something the interior designer finds deeply gratifying. "It's so rewarding to watch an outdated space be transformed into a refreshing modern oasis," she says. The design directive from her clients was simple: This room needed to look and feel absolutely luxurious. Brophy worked with Gormeran Construction (gormeranconstruction.com) to incorporate a stand-alone stone tub and Picasso marble shower, echoing the same marble on the countertop. Large-format limestone sets off a custom-crafted walnut vanity—flashed to make the space feel airier—and a small closet was added beside the sinks. The finishing touches were straight from Midas. "Burnished gold pendants add so much design and interest, and the hardware is like jewelry on the cabinets," says Brophy. "I really focused on blending the organic elements with a chic vibe." And her clients' reaction? "They love it; they couldn't believe how it turned out. It's their favorite space in the home," says Brophy with a satisfied smile.
